Homework Corrections

- 1. Take your original homework (or a printout of a pdf copy of it) and mark an X next to any untrue statement or incorrect diagram. You do not have to mark any incorrect statements that are correct logical conclusions of earlier incorrect statements.
- 2. For each X write a brief explanation of why the statement or drawing is incorrect, and (if possible) what would make the statement or drawing correct. Draw a rectangular box around each explanation.
- 3. Write down any omitted statements or steps necessary to complete the problem correctly. Circle these steps.

If you need extra room to write down explanations or omissions draw a boxed number or letter (for explanations) or a circled number or letter (for omissions) and then write your answers in a clear space or new page with the corresponding number or letter.

4. Submit your homework annotated with explanations and omissions.
