1. Prepare a 1 minute persuasive speech to either support or oppose the idea that property crime is a serious problem in the United States. If your last name is in the beginning of the alphabet (A–K), you should argue that property crime is a serious problem. If your name is in the latter part of the alphabet (L–Z) you should argue that property crime is not a serious problem. Take the 1 minute time limit seriously—during class you will be timed on the speech, so make sure you can give it in one minute or less. You will give your speech to a group of 6–8 classmates and they will evaluate how persuasive it is.

To help in preparing your speech, you should download the Department of Justice crime statistics for 2015 at http://www.bjs.gov/content/pub/pdf/cv14.pdf. You should treat these statistics as the truth (i.e., assume the methodology is reasonable; dont spend your time in the speech questioning these statistics).
